Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump for each ring, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

**Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020**

**Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day**

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned on either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

**Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)**

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact and allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the T2B and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the

A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any course time – not max course time.

**Fix and Go On (FNG)**

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis for time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt any time while on course when the dog’s performance of an obstacle is not to This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

**DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, PAL/ILP or an AKC Canine Partner. FEO/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partner approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial will be held under AKC rules and regulations for agility trials. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with these rules and regulations.

**Jump Height Cards:** All dogs (except with AKC jump height cards) **MUST** be measured by the judge before their **first** run. Measuring will take place at 8:00 a.m. If your dog is measured into a taller jump class, he must be moved up into it at the trial. **If your dog is measured down, he cannot move into a lower jump class!**

**Jump Height Card Process:** There is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*.

### **SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY**

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dog is familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unreasonable disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of entry fees paid will be made. The Cook Inlet Kennel Club, Sirius Ranch and its agents, employees, exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injuries to children.

The Club reserves the right to decline entries and may excuse any handler or dog for any reason, without refund. There shall be no recourse or claim against Cook Inlet Kennel Club, Sirius Ranch or any official thereof.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. No flexi leads are allowed on the property at Sirius Ranch. Dogs should not be off leash around private residences on the property.

### **REFUNDS**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of circumstances, fire, or act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner/handler or responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. Exhibitors are responsible for providing service through a public address system or for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring.

**Parents or Guardians** must be responsible for children. Children need the supervision of an adult at all times.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems it necessary.
